### Welcome Back

### STAAR Writing

The STAAR Writing Test will be given on Tuesday, March 28th. In order to preserve the security and confidentiality of the test, visitors will not be permitted in the building during testing days. Parents are still welcome to drop off any item at the front office and we will ensure that the student gets the item.

### Pre-K and Kindergarten Round Up

On the week of April 3-7, we will hold registration for all incoming Pre-K and Kindergarten students that are not already enrolled at Anderson. Any children who are 5 years old on or before September 1, 2107 are eligible to register for Kindergarten.

This year we will also register our incoming Pre-K students the week of April 3-7. Students registering for Pre-Kindergarten must be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2017 and meet eligibility requirements. To be eligible for pre-k, a student must meet one of the following criteria:

- Unable to speak and comprehend the English language
- Educationally Disadvantaged
- Dependent of the United States Armed Forces, member of the National Guard, or member of the Reserves who are currently on active duty or who were injured or lost his/her life on active duty
- Homeless
- In or has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services
