Passport to Learning: Elementary Bilingual Program Pre-K, K, 1st and 2nd Grades

Purpose: The purpose of summer school for bilingual students is to enhance skills needed in the areas of reading, language development, and math in both the English and Spanish languages. Small group instruction will be utilized to maximize student achievement.

- Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Inclement Weather Day: June 30th if needed

Course Offerings: Pre-K and K bilingual education is provided as per federal law. Bilingual 1st and 2nd grades are sponsored by CISD Title III federal funds.

Registration: Invitations for summer school have been sent through the Campus Contacts at the local campus. * Inclement weather day if needed: June 30th.

Transportation: Bus transportation will be provided for students as in the regular school year.

Summer School Guidelines:

1. Student selection criteria for 1st and 2nd grades are based on DRA/BAS reading levels, benchmarks, and common assessments. Not all students are invited to participate.
2. Students who miss more than three days will be withdrawn from the program.
3. A report card will be issued at the end of the camp to communicate progress.
4. The determination of whether a student passes to the next grade is made by the home campus.
5. Students will be properly dressed and groomed according to the standards of the regular school term.
6. CISD Code of Conduct rules will apply.

Summer Feeding Program:

CISD students are provided free breakfast and lunch through the Community Summer Feeding Program in which neighborhood children are invited to breakfast and lunch on the campuses listed above.
